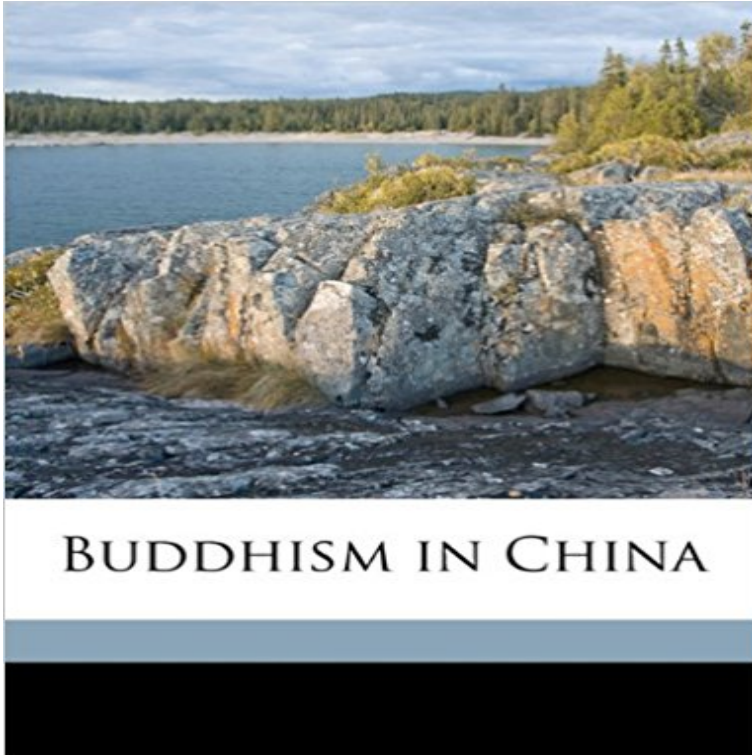


Buddhism in China
