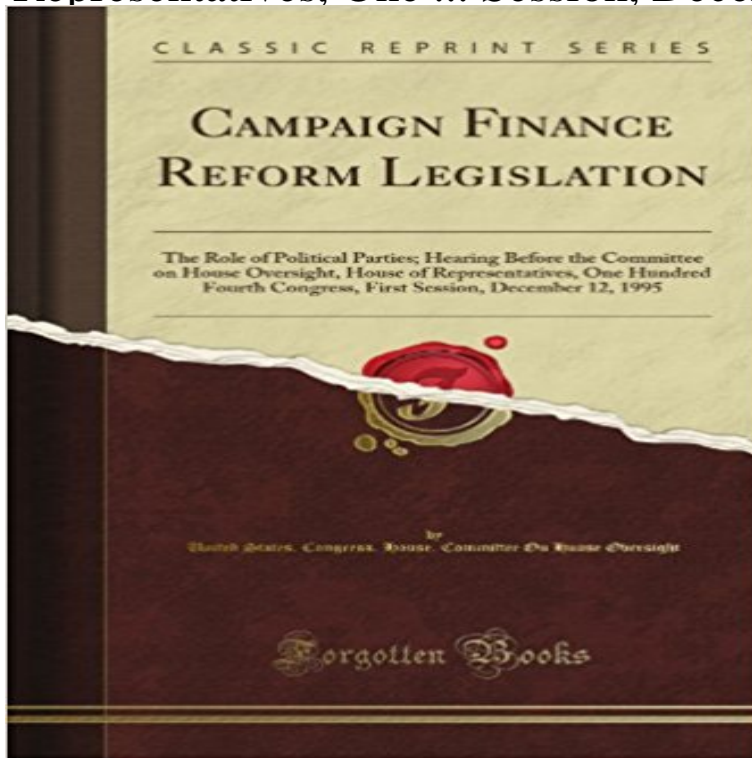


Campaign Finance Reform Legislation: The Role of Political Parties; Hearing Before the Committee on House Oversight, House of Representatives, One ... Session, December 12, 1995 (Classic Reprint)

The Chairman. The committee will come to order. I want to welcome the chairman of the Republican National Committee Haley Barbour, and the chairman of the Democratic National Committee Don Fowler, the other witnesses, guests, and the media. This is the third of our series of hearings on campaign finance reform, and obviously our goal is to provide as thorough a hearing as possible, reviewing those key areas in campaign finance that people believe should be reformed. One of the things that we want to try to minimize though we can never remove it entirely but to minimize, are the unintended consequences which I believe have been a significant part of campaign finance, especially since the 1970s. One of our greater concerns is that when you take a look at any recent public opinion poll, for example, Campaign for America recently asked respondents, which of the following do you think really controls the Federal Government in Washington? Twenty-five percent answered, the Republicans in Congress; 6percent answered, the President; and 6percent answered, the Democrats in Congress; but 49 percent responded, lobbyists and special interests. Ninety percent of respondents in this same survey agreed with the statement, that we need
