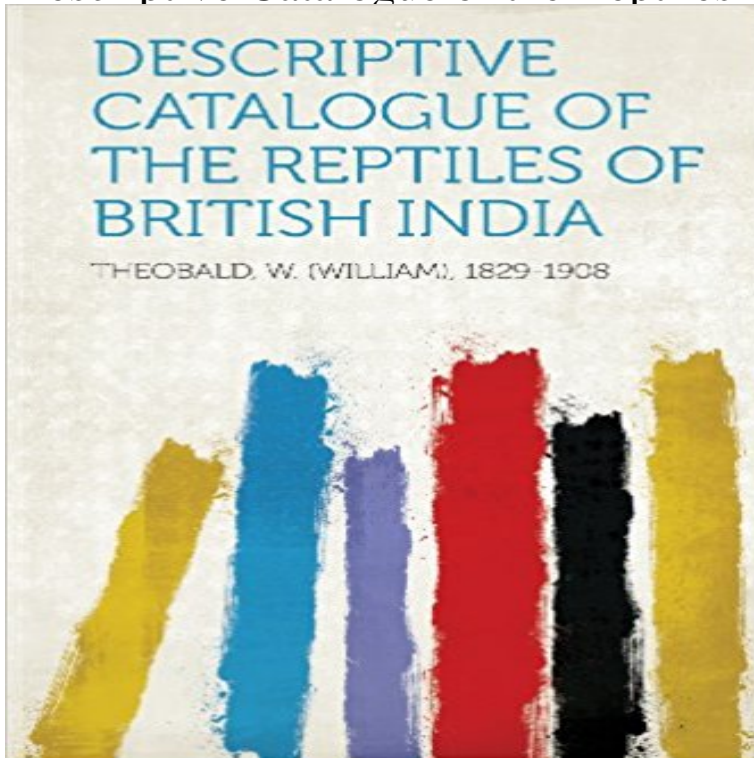


Descriptive Catalogue of the Reptiles of British India
