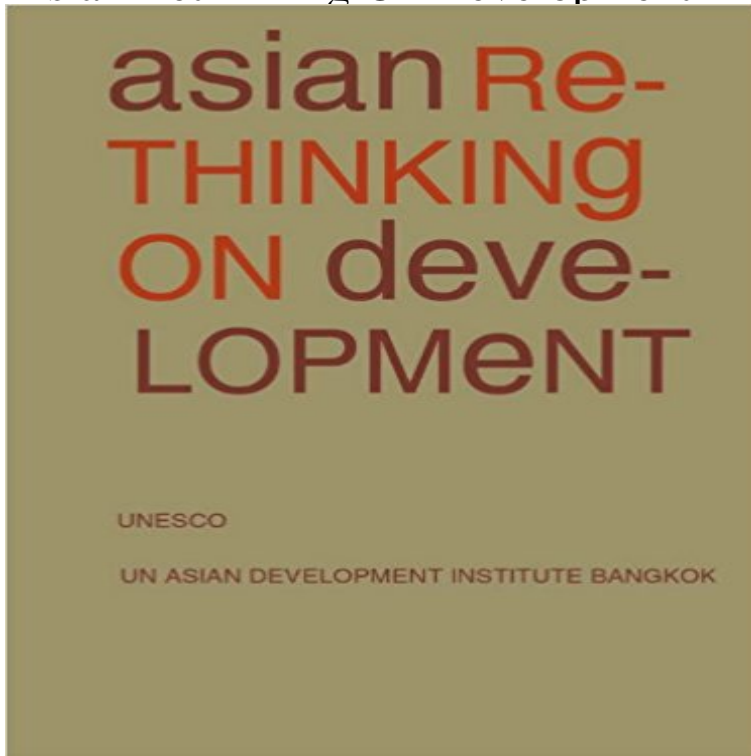


Asian Rethinking On Development
