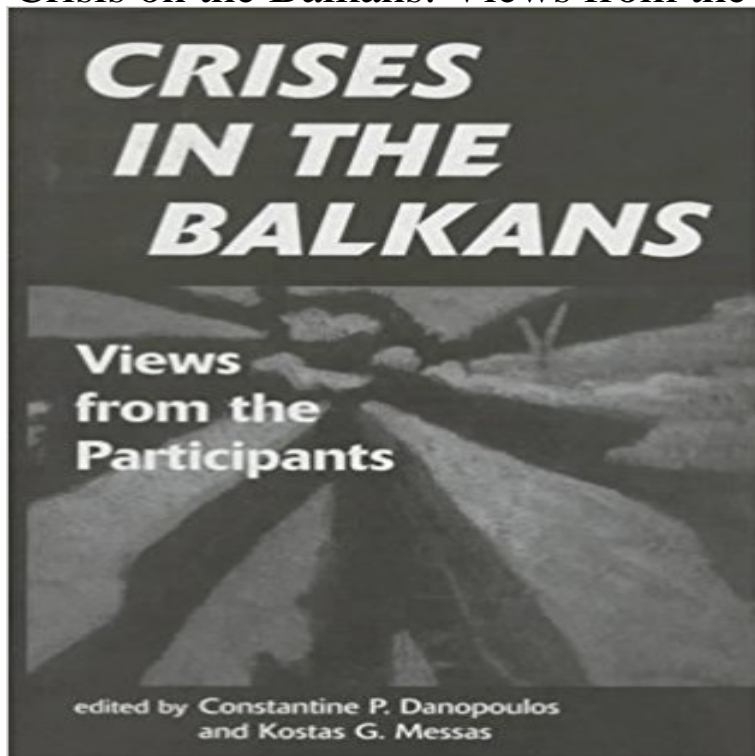


Crisis on the Balkans: Views from the Participants
