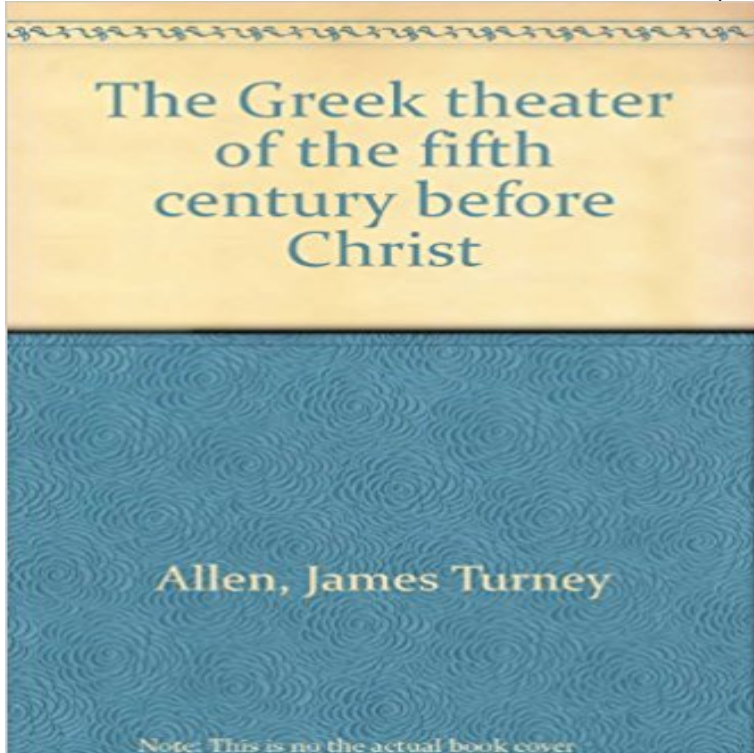


The Greek theater of the fifth century before Christ
