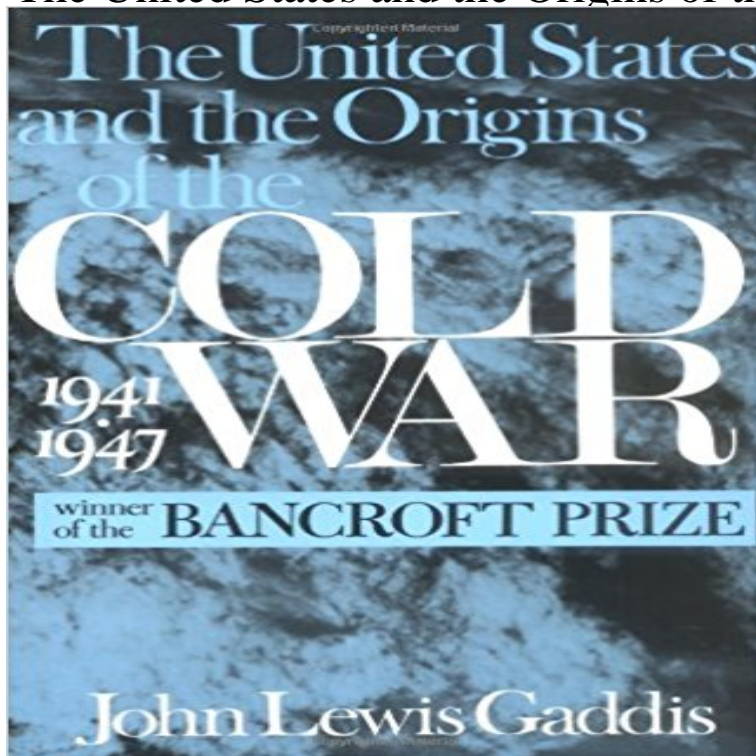


The United States and the Origins of the Cold War 1941-1947
